Bogans and Chavs: The stigmatisation of poverty in Australia and the UK

In this presentation, Dr Warr will discuss a project that focused on the stigmatisation of poverty from two angles: the perspectives of residents living in low-income neighbourhoods; and media discussions of 'bogans' and 'chavs'.

Residents' experiences offer insights into the effects of place-based stigma and were explored using arts-based methods.
